Libra Essay Prize Terms and Conditions

1. Terms and Conditions By entering this competition you agree to accept and be bound by these terms and conditions and acknowledge that failure to comply with them may result in disqualification. If the prize is declined or unclaimed by the winners, or if the winners cannot be contacted from the details supplied within 30 business days ("business day" meaning Monday to Friday, excluding bank holidays) of notification, replacement winners may be chosen at Libra Education's discretion and will be notified by Libra Education. The original entries that were chosen will then be disqualified.

4. Prizes¹ The following prizes shall be provided:

- (a) £75 (seventy five pounds Sterling) to the first winning entrant.
- (b) £50 (fifty pounds Sterling) to the second winning entrant.
- (c) £25 (twenty five pounds Sterling) to the third winning entrant.

(d) submitted via email to info@libraeducation.co.uk with the following specifications: between 1,000 – 2,000 words on any subject matter, with name, year group, and school in the email.

6.1 To ensure anonymity for the purposes of a fair judging process, entrants must not include their names on the body of their essay. Essay documents which include the entrant's name will be rejected from this Competition.

6.2 There will be no acknowledgment of receipt for entries submitted by post.
