Background

Jimmy was studying at a non-academic school in the UK and desperately needed to move in order to pursue his university and career aspirations.

Charterhouse and Rugby both required written applications, references, tests and 4 interviews (excluding scholarship exams) in order to make a successful application.

Background

Qijia was living in Shanghai where she attended boarding school. After travelling to the UK, the family decided they wanted Qijia to enter the UK school system to study GCSEs, A Levels and hopefully at university in the future.

UK school applicants usually have reserve spaces on waiting lists for the top UK schools, however, Qijia wanted to apply with less than a year before entry in September 2021.

All three schools required a personal statement, admissions testing and an interview and had only one or two spaces available to admit students at 14+ which is not a common entry point for independent schools in the UK.

Qijia needed to prepare for the admissions tests, which she had never been exposed to before, and to work on her confidence to present herself in the best light during the interview.

Background

Yale originally lived and attended school in Shanghai. As the family were making plans to travel to the UK, they needed to find the perfect school to suit Yale and develop his academic career.

Several of the five schools applied to were competitive and required a good grasp of reading and writing in English in order to perform well in examinations, an area that Yale was less confident in. Although Yale did well in subjects in school, he faced the challenge of translating his success into an English curriculum.

Yale also needed to prepare for written and online admissions tests in another language, which required learning new formats and developing his confidence in applying his English correctly. Yale was originally turned down by all of his choices, however, Libra Education used their connections to turn this into a positive decision and ensure he had a place at one of his 5 schools.

In order to turn her around, Libra recommended she attend one of their London Residentials. During this bootcamp, Helen had her lessons outside whilst walking in order to break down the barriers to her communication and to develop her interpersonal skills.

Over the 10-day course, Helen was supported to discuss her own motivation rather than that of her family. This is key requirement of top UK schools.
